2. Spectators and competitors attend entirely at their own risk. The organisers and Hartpury College do not accept liability for any accident, damage or injury to horse, rider, spectators or property.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, limit the number of entries, cancel or split a class. **ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED IN CLASSES ONE, TWO AND FOUR.**
4. Late pre-entries at the Organisers' discretion.
5. No entries will be refunded, except on production of a Medical Certificate.
6. Abuse of the horse, bad language or behaviour will not be tolerated and will risk elimination.
7. Objections in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident with a £20 deposit non-refundable if over-ruled
8. No haynets outside your box and no horses to be tied up outside unattended.
